Call to Order

Chair Holladay called the meeting to order. A quorum was declared.

Approval of the Minutes

Mr. Myers moved to approve the August 5, 2015 minutes. Ms. Milliken seconded the motion. Motion passed.

Update – Mobile Food Vendor

Mr. Holladay stated that a joint meeting between the Farragut Business Alliance, the Planning Commission and the Economic Development Committee will be on September 9, 2015 at 9:00AM. Mr. Smoak stated that he contacted Rick Emmett and Patricia Robledo with the City of Knoxville regarding vending trucks; the City does not get any sales tax revenue from the vending truck sales. Ms. Milliken stated that she is concerned about how vending trucks will impact signage in the Town.

Status Updates

- a. **Town of Farragut:** Presented by Mr. Smoak
 - i. Approximately 75 new residential building permits so far this year; 4 in August

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- ii. The Planning Commission recommended to deny the rezoning request on Smith Road. Planned to be presented to the Board of Mayor and Alderman on September 10, 2015.
- iii. Planning Commission approved Town Center District zoning for approximately 16 acres by the Outdoor Classroom and Village Vet. The first reading for the Board is scheduled for September 24, 2015.
- iv. Public Forum with Duncan Associates will be at 7 PM on September 16, 2015 to discuss impact fees.
- v. Currently working on a new retail flyer that will hopefully be finished by the end of September.
- vi. Public Forum with TDOT will be held at Two Rivers Church on September 3 from 5-7 PM to discuss the Dixie Lee Junction Project.

b. Farragut / West Knox Chamber of Commerce: Presented by Ms. Sisco

- i. 4 new members in August
- ii. 4 Networking Events and 7 Ribbon Cuttings in August
- iii. Over 145 people attended the Chamber Breakfast
- iv. The 5k will be October 24, 2015
- v. Chamber Open House has been scheduled for December 8, 2015

c. Farragut Business Alliance: Presented by Ms. Sousa

- i. The FBA board reaffirmed support of the rezoning request made by Continental Properties
- ii. Working on sustainability plan with a subcommittee
- iii. Launched the new FBA website. Currently working on rebranding to be in line with the Town's new brand
- iv. Taste of Farragut will be September 25, 2015. 25 VIB ("Very Important Bites") tickets have already sold.
