- I. The meeting was called to order by Chair Pennycuff-Trent. A quorum was declared. Members present were Carla Werner, Tony Carasso, and Drew Carson, as well as Gary Palmer and Jennifer Hatmaker of the Town Administration. Alderman Ron Honken was also present.

 - b. FY2016 grants will be presented to the five schools, the Farragut High School Education Foundation, and the Hardin Valley Academy Foundation at the September 24, 2015 Board of Mayor and Alderman meeting.
 - c. Alderman Honken asked the committee for their input on a Teacher Appreciation Program. Alderman Honken stated that he would like to see the Town provide an annual award to teachers, possibly one award per school. Ms. Werner stated that allowing principals to make the selection for the award could be a biased decision. Ms. Werner suggested that the Town could pay for a day off for the teacher selected. Alderman Honken stated that the Farragut Business Alliance may want to be involved, offering a free gift from local businesses as part of the award and suggested inviting the award recipients to the Introduction to Farragut Program Graduation. Mr. Palmer suggested inviting the award recipients to the committee banquet. Mr. Palmer stated he would work on the framework for the program.
