**School Liaison Updates**

St. John Neumann

- October 4: Out of Uniform fundraiser to benefit Hurricane Helene relief in North Carolina with material items or cash

- The St. John Neumann community contributed 1 pickup truck load of items for Catholic Charities of East TN that went to Johnson County, TN.
- 3 pickup truck loads and a 12-foot trailer full of items were taken to Mitchell County, NC.
- 2 pickup truck loads and the trailer load to the Superintendent of Mitchell County Schools and he helped to get the items to some of the communities most in need.
- 1 pickup truck load went to the Avery/Mitchell Counties airport where private individuals were using their personal aircraft to deliver supplies to communities, which were still cut off from the outside world.
- The Athletic Department hosted a tournament for Knoxville Independent Schools League Junior Varsity and Varsity volleyball teams and collected supplies in lieu of admissions.
