We will also be receiving information later in the year after Town Staff completes research on current field rental fees in the Knoxville and local areas. Fees will be re-examined at that time. Lauren stated that our synthetic fields and all our fields are remaining very popular and in constant use with team practices, games and tournaments. There are already 16 Soccer tournaments on the books for next year. Our tourism department has been doing a tremendous amount of work reaching out to the teams and the hotels and motels in Farragut to provide information to them regarding the many opportunities for lodging, activities, eating and shopping in the Town. There is a website VisitFarragut.org that has been developed and has great details and direction for visitors to the area.

We were urged to attend the community meeting on Monday, August 20 at 6 PM at Town Hall to help provide ideas and input regarding the needs, wishes, activities and opportunities at the new community center.
