



PARKS AND ATHLETICS COUNCIL MINUTES

MEETING DATE: JUNE 8, 2021

Meeting called to order at 6:05 PM on 6/8/21

Approval of minutes - Devlin made a motion, Gellar seconded, all present were in favor

Youth representative selection - Devlin made a motion to select Ria Padhye, Pinchok seconded, all present were in favor.

Field allocation pre-discussion

- Diamond fields - no conflicts
- Rectangle fields - a lot to discuss
- Solar Storm is new
- FCA and KFC - long-time, reliable users, no issues with them
- TN Select - no issues, newer user
- KUSA - long-time user, some history of payment problems, paid up front last year
- KMSL - adult soccer club, long-time user, no issues
- LCUSL - no issues since trash cleanup fee instituted
- ORCFC - small group, not competitive
- CBFO - Soccer Shots, FC National - no conflicts

Other Business

- FC Alliance has submitted many tournament requests.
 - o How do we balance and prevent monopolization of fields?
 - o Do we limit to one tournament per month?
 - o What is the impact on tourism?
 - o Require 2-day tournaments only in prime season?
 - o Need to set some form of a cap.

Devlin made a motion to adopt the following proposal:

- 2 weekends per month maximum per group
- 3 weekends per season maximum per group
- At least 1.5 days per weekend
- If weekends open post field allocation, more may be booked

Brock seconded the above motion, all present were in favor.

We need to consider raising fees in the future to control demand.

Sue Stuhl introduced feedback from Parks and Rec Master Plan focus groups (handout).

This information will be critical during fall P&A Council meetings for future master planning.

Sue wants council members to visit parks to have first-hand opinions based on experience.

Ullian made a motion to adjourn, Gellar seconded, all present were in favor.
