Minutes

1. Call to order 3:32pm

2. Approval of Minutes: Valerie made a motion to approve the November minutes and all were in favor, except Marie who wasn't at the November meeting.
3. Old Business
 - A. Language Charter Amendment: Joe proposed the following added to the end of the 1st paragraph under Membership: If applications for voting membership to the committee do not include these specific specialists, other individuals may be appointed at the discretion of the FBMA, preferably individuals with interest, knowledge, and expertise in stormwater management, environmental issues, or science.
