New Members

OLD BUSINESS

Riparian Buffer

Robin asked if the Riparian Buffer workshop will be rescheduled. Lori said it will be, but there hasn't been a date set yet.

Outdoor Classroom

Lori spoke about utilizing the Outdoor Classroom for the local schools on a teaching and volunteering basis. In regards to the Outdoor Classroom shed, it is considered a minor project. A green roof puts too much weight and would require engineering plans so this will not be part of the plan. This will be a good project for the Eagle Scout involved in the project. He will have to finish by his 18th birthday (June). Lori is thinking near the existing pavilion.

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Watershed Plan

Plans to have the new AmeriCorps member help with the Watershed Plan. Robin asked what a watershed plan contains. Lori said that the EPA has 9 components and it involves technical watershed information, stakeholders, etc. This is the first step in a long-term plan. Ed said that this is really needed since, for example, it is important to know where the water is going in the new subdivisions.

Stormwater Infrastructure Mapping

Lori is working with the Water Resources Research Center to perform the mapping. Wants to get a better understanding of the condition in order to get a better idea of the maintenance. It is going to be presented to the board July 27th.
