Stormwater Infrastructure Mapping

They won't have to go through other people's property and are starting with Village Green, Fox Den, and King's Gate. Wanted to start with the oldest neighborhoods first.

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Shed at the Outdoor Classroom

Lori has someone working on the shed design. It will be an Eagle Scout project. Joe is a Boy Scout troop leader and in the past has been very helpful in identifying Eagle Scout candidates, for this project his name is Will. It is a big project since the shed is at least 10x10, has to meet the building codes, have to get a building permit, and get it inspected it, etc. Public works is going to pour the foundation and the money will come out of the stormwater project. He will have until the end of June to complete it since it needs to be completed before his 18th birthday (because of the Eagle Scout requirement).
