Call to Order

Ed Whiting called the meeting to order at 3:54 pm, following the committee photo.

Approval of the Minutes

Ken Hawkins made a motion to approve the July 12, 2018 meeting minutes. Valerie McFall seconded, and all were in favor.

Stormwater Coordinator Report

The Town of Farragut (TOF) had a comprehensive and successful audit with the State of Tennessee Department of Environment and Conservation (TDEC). A formal letter with the findings and suggestions and method for response will be received shortly. The draft findings were presented to the committee.

Business Items

The TOF SAC 2018 Annual Report had been presented at the previous meeting for review. Comments were addressed in a revised version for this meeting. Specifically, modification were made to sections Stormwater Program Overview and Summary of Committee Activities. The revised document was approved by the committee.

TOF participation in the National Wildlife Federation (NWF) Community Wildlife Habitat program was discussed. Information was provided on the program and requirements for certification. It was agreed that the program was of interest to pursue certification, and that additional information was needed. The TOF Stormwater Coordinator will compile information on how many requirements for certification are either complete or easily accomplished (within ~3 months of request for certification) as well as what the largest challenges might be to certification. She will also approach TOF management for concurrence to pursue the certification and look into the requirements for recertification. The biggest challenge most likely will be engaging community commitment for the number of habitats/properties required. Town properties such as the Outdoor Classroom, Founders Park and Greenways could also be habitats.
