Call to Order

Approval of the Minutes

Robin Hill made a motion to approve the August minutes, Valerie McFall seconded and all were in favor.

Stormwater Coordinator Report

AmeriCorps member status-we have an AmeriCorps member scheduled to start in a few weeks.

NOV report-there is one open NOV, contact has been made and progress is being made to resolve the NOV.

Business Items

1. TDEC-required Stormwater Ordinance Revisions

The changes to the ordinances were discussed. Robin Hill made a motion to adopt the recommended changes to the Stormwater Ordinance, Valerie McFall seconded and all were in favor.

2. Recommendation to pursue certification as a National Wildlife Federation Certified Wildlife Community

TOF participation in the National Wildlife Federation (NWF) Community Wildlife Habitat program was discussed. The TOF Stormwater Coordinator compiled information on how many requirements for certification are either complete or easily accomplished (within ~3 months of request for certification), what the largest challenges might be to certification as well as the requirements for recertification. The committee reviewed the requirements for certification and recertification.

Robin Hill made a motion for the Stormwater Advisory Committee to pursue the National Wildlife Federation Certified Wildlife Community Certification, Valerie McFall seconded and all were in favor.

Other Discussion

Sinkhole Ordinance – Robin Hill mentioned that he feels the stormwater committee should be more involved with decisions regarding variances to the sinkhole ordinance. The committee discussed the issue briefly.
