Call to Order

Ed Whiting called the meeting to order at 3:45 pm.

Approval of the Minutes

Approval of the April and June meeting minutes was tabled until the August meeting due to lack of a quorum.

Election of Officers

Election of officers was tabled until the August meeting due to a low number of committee members present.

Stormwater Coordinator Report

Stormwater System Mapping:

1. At the Board of Mayor and Alderman meeting on August 8, 2019, Members from the UT Water Resources Research Center will present their findings of the most recent phase of stormwater infrastructure mapping and assessment. The presentation is likely to occur in a workshop setting prior to the formal meeting.
2. The Town contracted with a company to inspect via CCTV about 15 CMP stormwater pipes throughout the town. The inspections have been completed and staff is awaiting the report and videos.
3. Staff from the engineering department is working on a RFQ for mapping the remainder of the town's stormwater infrastructure. Staff has researched the cost of purchasing their own equipment for CCTV pipe inspections but has not made any decisions regarding the next steps.

Wonderful Wildlife:

1. A church youth group will in installing a pollinator at the outdoor classroom this month.
2. The AmeriCorps member has been working to identify subdivisions that can easily obtain the Garden for Wildlife certification. She will be reaching out to representatives of those

subdivisions to inquire about moving forward with the certification. The AmeriCorps member is also working to identify town parks that qualify or nearly qualify for the certification.

3. Staff is planning on hosting a bat box workshop in October. Staff from TWRA and TVA will be presenting information on bats and bat box kits will be available for attendees to assemble and take home.
4. The town is close to achieving the points required to satisfy registration, administration, education and outreach requirements of the certification process. The above projects will enable to town to satisfy those requirements.
