Call to Order

Violet Freudenberg called the meeting to order at 3:52 pm.

Approval of the Minutes

September minutes: Valerie McFall motioned to approve the September minutes. Violet seconded the motion. All were in favor.

Stormwater Coordinator Report

Stormwater System Mapping:

1. The UT report will be used as input information into the anticipated, new stormwater infrastructure mapping contract rather than pursuing further detail and addition to the current report.
2. Mapping of the Fox Run infrastructure was chosen as a proof of process for the chosen consultant due to variety of stages and ages of the infrastructure in that subdivision.

Current NOV's:

Two NOV's are open. One for Easton Park on Turkey Creek is almost resolved. The second at the Overlook at Campbell Station is expected to be on-going. Two other non-NOV incidents were investigated: potential for Grigsby Park land disturbance to have filled a stream and tree removal behind SE Bank which broke the stream bank.

Events:

- A successful bat box workshop was held. All 10 bat boxes planned were purchased.

- The Tennessee Stormwater Meeting will be next week at Montgomery Bell State Park.
- A TWRA grant request was submitted which may allow for purchase of additional trees for a stream buffer repair event.

Community Wildlife Certification Status:

All internal requirement for the certification are believed to be complete. Some activities still require acceptance for the points. Working now on ideas for property certifications. Louise Povlin expressed interest in the requirements for designation as Tree City USA.

Adopt-a-Stream Clean-up:

A stream cleanup on Turkey Creek near the Dairy Queen was performed by the SAC in Oct. It was discussed whether a different area or activity should be performed for the Spring 2020 event.

- Establish mini-grants that could be applied for. Criteria would need to be written. Add to agenda for SAC.
- More signage. Investigate what the requirements are for consistency vs. use of local artwork and ideas for signs.
