Call to Order:

Ken called the meeting to order at 3:50pm.

Approval of the Minutes:

Valerie made a motion to approve minutes, Violet seconded and all were in favor.

Stormwater Coordinator Report:

- a. Stormwater system mapping project update
 - i. CEC under contract for pilot study of Fox Run.
 - ii. Preliminary information on Monday, 1st/2nd week of January. They will start at Fox Run and continue for approximately 6-8 weeks.
 - iii. ArcGIS will be online and will be live.
 - iv. There is money in this fiscal year's budget to replace pipes.
- b. Current NOVs
 - i. Only one open: Easton Park by Turkey Creek. Should be closed soon.
 - ii. SouthEast bank site (TDEC) – Stream crossing, will repair damage but it is minor.
 - iii. Grisby Park (TDEC) – Was not a stream, but it does have mapped wetlands. Could possibly be jurisdiction of the US Army Corps of Engineers.

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Other Discussion:

- a. Use of the Outdoor Classroom
 - i. Environmental group at Farragut High School – Lori will contact the teacher. Discussion regarding contacting the new principal, Dr. Bartlett. Will try to touch base with Farragut High School administration and clubs. Audrey discussed investigating interest at the high school and also contacting the clubs.
 - ii. Looking into ideas/projects that are ongoing at the classroom. Maintenance can be challenging and needs to be considered.
 - iii. Re-market the grants, such as beehives (this requires a fence), to bring in new projects and ideas. Would like to see a project in the open space such as an erosion demonstration.
 - iv. Different challenges such as no bathrooms. Also discussed if the public perceives that the Outdoor Classroom is for Farragut High School students since the high school sign is in the same area.
 - v. Repairs to the shed in the Outdoor Classroom: Shelf space, peg board, etc.
 - vi. Teacher workshops in the summer when school is not in session.
