The following announcements were made:

Freaky Friday Fright Night – this successful event was attended by over 2,500 children. All 2,500 pencils were given out and more were needed. There was plenty of candy so the Arts Council members had something to give everyone. Next year more pencils will be ordered and Arts Council members decided not to give out candy. Next year the booths will be spread around an additional ball field to spread out the crowd.

Arts Council Logo – Ideas were given to Lauren for the Arts Council logo. Lauren will submit them to the graphic artist and she will e-mail the proposed logo to the Arts Council members for their comments. The graphic artist will be asked to update the Book Fest logo as well and it will be presented to the Arts Council members for comments.

Middle School Art Show – Invitations will be sent to the middle school teachers in December so they will have the information before the next semester starts. Nancy Wentz will find judges

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for the event. This will be a juried show with gift cards being given to the winners. There will be a reception on Tuesday, April 5, 2016.

Advanced Middle School Art Show – This art show is scheduled for January 11-22, 2016 and will not be juried nor will there be a reception.

High School Art Show – This event I scheduled in April with the reception to be on April 19 and will be a juried show with gift cards to the winners. Nancy Wentz will investigate having a harpist from the high school play during the reception.

Book Fest – This event is scheduled for April 9, 2016. This will follow the same format as in previous years. Coloring books and crayons will be given out to all children. The entertainment will be similar to last year with the exception of Michael Messing will be doing only one show and the Bright Star Touring Theatre will present two plays, The Reluctant Dragon and Upcycled Cinderella. A Book Fest meeting will be held in January. Letters to businesses asking for donation will be sent out in December. Lauren will bring additional information to the next meeting.
