Review Arbor Day celebration schedule and events

Intermediate School Component

Suzanne Parham, the Principal of the Farragut Intermediate School, will attend the meeting. The program we're planning for Farragut Intermediate School students includes the following:

1. The Town will distribute to the school coloring sheets for the students with the title/theme Trees are Terrific in Farragut; completed coloring sheets will be hung in the Town Hall during the week of our Arbor Day celebration.
2. Diane Warwick, Urban & Community Forestry Program Coordinator with the Tennessee Department of Agriculture, Division of Forestry, will speak during an assembly about the value of trees and what they do. The assembly is intended for all the classes of Third Grade. This is scheduled for the morning of February 17.
3. A tree will be planted on the Farragut Intermediate School campus (approximately 2" caliper).

Discussion Items: Supplies, setting up at Town Hall for display of coloring sheets, verifying tree location, ordering tree, staffing event.
