1. Minutes:

2. Ground Mounted Sign Applications:

a) Autumn Care III Assisted Care Living Facility – 400 Herron Road 21 square foot externally illuminated ground mounted sign

The staff reviewed this item and recommended approval subject to verification of the setbacks, height, and lighting. A motion was made by Anderson to approve the sign subject to staff recommendations. Motion was seconded by Kiumarsi and motion passed unanimously.

b) First Bank – 11820 Kingston Pike 36 square foot replacement sign face on ground mounted sign

c) AT&T – 11555 Parkside Drive 40 square foot replacement sign face on ground mounted sign
