Call to Order: The meeting was called to order at 5:30 p.m. by President Sandy Garber.

Approval of August Minutes: Minutes were approved as submitted.

Review of Planning Goals for Fiscal Year 2017-2018:

Barbara West Portrait Group Exhibit

Motion was made by Pam Ziegler and seconded by Beverley Hammond that the Arts Council would assist in hanging the Portrait Group exhibit in the Town Hall Rotunda on October 16 at 9:00 a.m. Motion carried.

Motion was made by Pam Ziegler and seconded by Jennifer Roche that Arts Council will be present at 5.p.m. on October 17 to assist with Art Show Reception; motion carried.

Since the Council will be assisting with the reception, Lauren Cox asked group if it would be acceptable to move October 3 Council Meeting to October 17, following reception. Council was in agreement.

Middle School Juried Art Show and Reception

There was discussion concerning obtaining a judge for show. Nancy Wentz volunteered to find judge.

Eleventh Annual Book Fest for Children

Jennifer Roche inquired about participation of Imagination Library and that organization having a role in Book Fest. It was the view of other Arts Council members that Imagination Library could sign up for a booth as do participating authors.

Pleasant Forest Cemetery Living History Event, June 8, 2018

Lauren Cox announced the Farragut Arts Council would meet at the Town Hall on Sunday, September 24, at 3:30 p.m. for a group tour of the "Old Gray Cemetery" in Knoxville. The group will travel by Town of Farragut van to site. Hours for event are 4pm to 7pm. Historian who is assisting Farragut Arts Council will accompany group.

Robert Warren, Hardin Valley Academy, has agreed for \$450 to:

-- develop script for characters in our living history project

-- coordinate purchase of selected costumes, with assistance from
Director of Farragut Museum

-- participate as a character in the living history

Arts Council members were pleased of his decision.

Other Items

Louise Polvin, Councilwoman for Town of Farragut, and Steve Krempasky, Executive Director for Farragut Business Alliance, attended meeting to discuss possible venues where Farragut Arts Council and Farragut Art/Business Alliance might develop partnerships. A number of items were discussed, i.e., *Art in the Park*, sponsored by Art/Business Alliance.

Lauren Cox commented the long-standing Book Fest should remain separate from Art in the Park. There would be a definite increase in budget and create strain on town employees who set up event. President Garber asked that a partnership with the Art and Business Alliance be tabled for further discussion.

Steve Krempasky stated he had left-over art supplies from Art in the Park along with folding door panels and pegboards that need to be removed from one of his warehouses. He asked if the Arts Council would be interested in having some of it. Lauren Cox stated Arts Council could use the supplies and she would call to set up visit.

All other Arts Council Planning Goals for FY-2017-2018 remain as presented.
