September 11, 2025

The meeting was called to order at 4:48 pm by Beth Duncan. Quorum present.

Appointment of Officers

- Due to the absence of voting committee members, Alderman Cain moved to defer appointment of officers to the October 13, 2025 committee meeting. Yolanda Catlett seconded the motion. Members approved the motion to defer appointment of officers until October 13, 2025 by 4-0 vote.

Approval of Minutes

- Alderman Cain moved to approve committee minutes from the May 5, 2025 and July 7, 2025 meetings as written. Chairperson Beth Duncan seconded the motion. Members approved the motion to approve committee minutes from the May 5, 2025 and July 7, 2025 meetings as written by 4-0 vote.

Other Business

- Chris Sheffield reminded members of the roles and responsibilities under the Sunshine Law/Open Records Act.
- Committee members discussed possible goals and objectives for the 2025/2026 academic year. The following recommendations were discussed:
 - Sarah Toliver recommended focusing efforts on supporting upcoming events by providing earlier notifications rather than focus on previous events.

- Beth Duncan recommended partnering with students and the town staff to determine a recent history of the Town grant program to determine how long school grant amounts have been set at \$27,000, how grant money has been spent by schools, and whether the current grant amount reflects an appropriate value based on growth or should the committee advocate for additional funds in the next fiscal year.
- Rebecca Pack recommended sharing information that enables more FHS student volunteer opportunities to help younger students.
- Frank Yang recommended reconsidering goals and objectives in the October meeting, after student clubs and organizations have an opportunity to meet and coordinate their own goals.
- Chris Sheffield recommended the committee consider support to the Town's Arbor Day event at FIS, partnership with the Town's Introduction to Farragut program with volunteer opportunities at FPS, involvement in the Holiday Tree Village at McGill Plaza, or the development of a shared education-related event calendar.

Vice Chair: In the absence of the Chair, the Vice Chair shall perform the duties of the Chair.

Secretary: Record and maintain accurate records and minutes of proceedings. In the absence of the Chair and the Vice Chair, the Secretary shall perform the duties of the Chair.
