MINUTES

I. Roll Call, Silent Prayer, Pledge of Allegiance

Mayor Williams called the meeting to order at 6:00 PM. Roll Call for attendance: Alderman LaCroix, Vice-Mayor Meyer, Alderman Burnette, Alderman Cain, Mayor Williams; in addition to staff and members of the press.

II. Approval of Agenda

Town Recorder Hailey Russell advised the board that Item 6B, originally posted as "Approval of Purchase for Microsoft 365 Licenses using NASPO Contract Number: CTR060028," should be amended to 'Approval to Purchase Microsoft 365 Licenses under Sourcewell - Technology Products & Solutions Contract No. 121923-SHI.' This reflects a new contract saving the Town \$1,424.04.

The Mayor also asked the board to amend the agenda to postpone Business Item A until the next meeting.

Motion was made to approve the agenda with the amendment to business item B and postponement to the next meeting for business item A. Moved by Mayor Williams, seconded by Vice-Mayor Meyer; voting yes, Alderman LaCroix, Vice-Mayor Meyer, Alderman Burnette, Alderman Cain, Mayor Williams; voting nay, None; motion Passed.

III. Approval of Minutes

A. July 9, 2026, Minutes

Motion was made to approve the July 9, 2026, minutes. Moved by Vice-Mayor Meyer, seconded by Alderman Burnette; voting yes, Alderman LaCroix, Vice-Mayor Meyer, Alderman Burnette, Alderman Cain, Mayor Williams; voting nay, None; motion Passed.

IV. Mayor's Report

Mayor Williams thanked everyone for a successful Fourth of July parade.

Alderman Cain noted that Party in the Park at the splash pad would be held Friday, July 24th, from 6:00 to 8:00 p.m., and advised that a glow-in-the-dark dance party for

children would be held at the Community Center on Friday, August 14th, the week following the start of school.

Alderman LaCroix addressed the unauthorized use of the Town seal in his campaign advertisements. He stated that upon being notified by Town Administrator David Smoak on July 22nd, he immediately removed the seal from all campaign materials. He clarified that he obtained the seal via a Google search, that no Town employees, equipment, files, email accounts, or other public resources were used, and that the Town did not endorse his campaign. He directed any questions regarding campaign finance disclosures to the Tennessee Registry of Campaign Finance, and provided his phone number for constituents wishing to contact him directly.

- a. Ordinance 26-14, an ordinance on second reading to amend the Farragut Code of Ordinances, Chapter 2-Administration, Article 6-Finance, Division 2-Purchasing Regulations.

Motion was made to approve Ordinance 26-14, an ordinance to amend the Farragut Code of Ordinances, Chapter 2-Administration, Article 6-Finance, Division 2-Purchasing Regulations on second and final reading. Moved by Vice-Mayor Meyer, seconded by Alderman Cain; voting yes Alderman LaCroix, Vice-Mayor Meyer, Alderman Burnette, Alderman Cain, Mayor Williams; voting nay, None; motion Passed.

Item was postponed.

- B. Amended Agenda Item: Approval to Purchase Microsoft 365 Licenses under Sourcewell Technology Products & Solutions Contract No. 121923-SHI

Motion was made to approve the purchase for the Microsoft 365 licenses using Sourcewell - Technology Products & Solutions Contract #121923-SHI up to the amount of \$31,889.08. Moved by Alderman Burnette, seconded by Alderman Cain;

voting yes, Alderman LaCroix, Vice-Mayor Meyer, Alderman Burnette, Alderman Cain, Mayor Williams; voting nay, None; motion Passed.
